

Community Service Projects

(for students, groups, organizations and businesses)

Due to our size, community service projects at WCGHS are limited. At this time, we are only accepting community service projects of 20 hours or more for working on-site at the shelter. But we still need your help!

Below is a sample of ways you can help WCGHS and give back to the community at the same time!

Pet Food Drives: Collect new, unopened bags or cans of food

- Grain Free Dog Food: Dry & Wet
- Cat Food: Friskies Pate Style Can, Temptations Treats

Donations: Solicit donations from stores or businesses

- Cat & Dog Toys
- Breakaway Cat Collars
- Gift Cards
- Cat & Dog Treats
- Auction Items & Gift Baskets for Raffles or Fundraisers



Fundraisers: Have a car wash or yard sale and donated the funds raised to WCGHS.

Make Dog & Cat Adoption Goodie Bags: Solicit items and prepare bags to go home with new adopters! Bags may include toys, treats, and other miscellaneous pet items.



Kitten Foster Care Kits: Kitten season is coming! Make care kits with items you have received from donations to help raise kittens.

Pennies4Paws: Collect pennies to donate toward animal care at the shelter. This is a great office, classroom/school fundraiser idea.

Sponsor a Pet: Raise money to sponsor the adoption fee, medical care or training of one of the WCGHS pets.

Make your Own: Make toys or natural treats for our shelter pets!

Do you like to build things? Make flower planters, benches, dog houses, or cat trees. Donate them to the shelter or sell them as a fundraiser for us.

Help us spruce up our grounds:

- Solicit for donations of flowers or plants and plant them around our building or in planters.
- Weeding and yard work
- Pressure Washing

Promote WCGHS in the Community:

- Take pictures of our animals and do a presentation at your school.
- Promote adoptions
