Humane Society for Southwest Washington accepts stray animals from the following jurisdictions:

- City of Vancouver
- City of Camas (dogs only)
- City of Washougal (dogs only)
- City of Ridgefield
- City of Battle Ground
- City of La Center

Citizens may bring stray animals to HSSW without an appointment during our business hours shown above.

Citizens may also call the following designated **animal control agencies** for assistance with pick-up, or if outside of HSSW business hours:

- **CITY OF WASHOUGAL AND CITY OF CAMAS: CAMAS-WASHOUGAL ANIMAL CONTROL**
Camas-Washougal Animal Control Officers are available 7 days a week, including holidays and evenings. Officers can be reached Monday – Friday from 9 am – 8 pm at 360-835-8701, or after hours at 360-693-3111 (request a Camas-Washougal Animal Control Officer).
- **CITY OF VANCOUVER, CITY OF LACENTER, UNINCORPORATED PARTS OF CLARK COUNTY: CLARK COUNTY ANIMAL CONTROL**
Officers can be reached Monday – Friday from 8:30 am – 4:30 pm at 360-397-2488. Clark County Animal Control does not currently offer after-hours services. However, if you have a qualifying emergency, please dial 311 to speak to dispatch and a Clark County Sheriff's Officer or City of Vancouver Police Officer may respond.
- **CITY OF BATTLE GROUND: BATTLE GROUND POLICE DEPARTMENT**
Officers can be reached Monday – Friday from 10 am – 5 pm at 360-342-5200.
- **CITY OF RIDGEFIELD: RIDGEFIELD POLICE DEPARTMENT**
Officers can be reached at 360-887-3556.

Currently HSSW is not able to accept healthy stray cats. If a stray cat is in need of help due to illness or injury, citizens may call HSSW or the designated animal control agency in the jurisdiction where the animal was found.
